Under the Mission Schools of Excellence, the state government will build 50,000 new classrooms and convert nearly 1 lakh existing dassrooms of government-run schools into smart classrooms uning 50 Eethonlogy, the prime minister said. "Using this technology, a teacher can impart realtime education to several schools in villages through online mode. Now, the best education and content

The increasingly sedentary lifestyle of younger generations, the increased occurrence of obesity, and her relatively low fitness level of so many people have also lead to a smaller group of potential police officer candidates. There is a huge manpower shortage in the police department. The police-population ratio, currently 192 policemen per lakh population, is less than

what is recommended by UN i.e. 222 policemen per lakh. There is now a serious requirement for the execution of the proposed system as the city population is growing and a stronger police force is needed to tackle crime and L & O situations. It is also reported that more and more police personnel were being diagnosed for hypertension, diabetes and stress-related aliments in the annual health screening camps. The situation is more or less the same in many stations in the city where police personnel are forced to put in extra hours. Their pervert mentality is reflected in the abusive language and falsehoods they are spreading about the state," he said in an attack aimed at AAP. AAP has been actively campaigning in Gujarat, where assembly polls

are due this year-end. The party got into trouble recently when a video surfaced and its state president fogal Italia was purportedly seen and heard abusing Mod as 'heech' (lowly person). Mod said some parties feel their deology is incomplete without showing Gujarat in a poor light. Not just Gujarat, but no one from any region of India should be subjected to slander, he said. Groundnut crop estimated at 29 lakh tonnes: Shri Saurashtra Oil Mills Association



RAJKOT: RAJKOT: Shri Saurashtra Oil Mills Association (SOMA), the apex body of oil millers in Gujarat has estimated the groundnut production this season to 29 lakh tonnes, four lakh tonnes

lakn tonnes, rour lakn tonnes less compared to last year. The estimates were released on Monday. The demand for groundnut has increased in the domestic market due to

drastically less harvest in southern states.

According to SOMA, 22 lakh tonnes of crop is expected from 10 districts of Saurashtra and the rest from Kutch and north Gujarat

Kutch and north Gujarat districts.

The average yield this year is 1,550 kg per hectare, which is said to be good compared to the previous years when the same was around 1,450 kg per hectare. SOMA estimates show that the highest production of 4.55 lakh tonnes is expected in Rajkot district followed by 4.24 lakh tonnes in Junagadh and 2.79 lakh tonnes in Devbhumi Dwarka district. Kishor Viradiya,

Kishor Viradiya, president of SOMA, said "This year, the total production is

less due to reduced area under cultivation." The overall cultivation area was down by around two lakh hectares as farmers found cotton and soybean

found cotton and soybean more lucrative.

Traders say groundnut has already started arriving in the market and the average rate for a good quality crop is around Rs 1,300 per 20 kg. The government procures the crop at Rs 1,170 per kg.

Incidentally, the Solvent Extractors' Association of India (SEAI) on Sunday estimated groundnut production in Gujarat to around 30 lakh tonnes in the current year.
